Local Affairs Dept. divies energy, mineral extraction revenues

DOLA 8/31 - The Department of Local Affairs (DOLA), Thursday, announced the total dollars local governments will be receiving as part of annual Severance Tax and Federal Mineral Lease Direct distributions to counties and municipalities.

State law directs DOLA to distribute 15 percent of the revenue collected in the Local Government Severance Tax Fund to counties or municipalities on the basis of the residence of severance taxpayer employees reported to the Department of Revenue by the severance taxpayers. This year's distribution totaled \$16,695,980.

Federal Mineral Lease Direct Distributions are revenues the state receives based upon energy and mineral extraction activities occurring on federal lands within Colorado. These funds are also distributed by the DOLA on the basis of the residence of production employees. This year's distribution (for 2005 and the first six months of 2006) totaled \$6,545,210.

The distribution of both funds is based on a newly revised methodology based on the counts of employees of energy and mineral producing companies. This new method is the result of an Attorney General's Opinion (AGO) reinterpreting the manner in which Federal Mineral Lease funds were to be distributed and a subsequent Task Force convened in 2005 by DOLA.

The Task Force, which consisted of county, municipal and industry representatives to review and make recommendations on improving the employee count process, achieved consensus on the method for determining the share allocated to each local government.

An Oversight Committee, also consisting of county, municipal and industry representatives has been established to participate on an annual basis to review the proposed allocations based on industry employee counts provided by the energy industry to the Colorado Department of Revenue (DOR).

Barbara Kirkmeyer, director of DOLA's Division of Local Government said, "We are confident the data used

to distribute both Federal Mineral Lease and Severance Direct Distributions are now more accurate than at any time in the past. We thank our local government and industry partners who assisted in this effort."

New PR campaign, but no new ideas...

While the Iraqi Civil War rages on, our General Casey this week announced that he thinks Iraqis will be able to do all their own policing within a year and a half and he thinks American forces may be cut slightly after that.

In other words, Casey is as out of touch as Bushy. Iraqi militia and insurgents killed over 300 of their fellow citizens just this week, in spite of extra American forces being shifted into Baghdad a month ago to "quell" the city's violence.

New Big Lie...

Bushy has launched a speaking tour invoking a new scenario to sway public opinion on the Iraq fiasco. He is now portraying our struggle to stop terrorism as a vast, century-long task. Speaking to Legionnaires in Utah, George said the 20th Century was occupied with our defeat of fascism, nazism, and communism; now, our challenge for the 21st Century is to defeat terrorism. The aim of this scenario is, seemingly, to convince Americans that George's War on Terrorists will last 100 years, so we should patiently send our troops to engage the enemy, kill, be killed and be maimed, for the next five generations.

George is telling us that we must be willing to send young Americans to invade and occupy other nations for the next 94 years! He now wants us to believe this struggle requires the lives and limbs of our children, our grandchildren, our great grandchildren and *their* children and grandchildren.

What George and his cronies at the top seem to be preparing us for is the reinstatement of the draft or some other gimmick to expand our military. George's speeches indicate that he and his friends are convinced that we must attack many more nations and engage them in conventional warfare.

In their hearts, they still don't quite get it...

It is clear now that Bushy and his gang are finally admitting to themselves that a part of their failure in Iraq and Afghanistan is their shortage of military personnel for the job they set out to do. That they are arrogant and ignorant is the real cause of their failure, but they cannot face this fact yet, even in their most secret thoughts.

At any rate, their fixation with conventional warfare spells more unnecessary tragedy for our nation because this is not a conventional struggle.

A little history of retreat...

Bush's cry that we cannot withdraw from Iraq or we will face the enemy here at home is a paper tiger they propound. It's either because they are lying out of desperation or, more likely, because they misunderstand military tactics.



The Russians defeated Western Europe's two greatest military machines with the tactic of strategic withdrawal (otherwise known as retreat). By following Russia's strategic holding actions and retreats, the forces of both Napoleon and Hitler exhausted and depleted themselves.

George Washington lost and retreated again and again until, with the overwhelming aid and expertise of the French and others, he trapped the British at Yorktown. The French general then graciously let George preside at the surrender.

Brute force vs. humanity...

The Israeli air force performed its bombing, strafing, and rocketing duties in a most efficient and terrible fashion over Lebanon during the past month. But this did not achieve their goal of destroying the Hezbollah militants. This overwhelming air power created terror among the Lebanese, thus creating tens of thousands more enemies for Israel. This teaches the lesson that our overwhelming air power cannot win any conflict. It didn't in World War II, nor in Korea, nor Vietnam. And it cannot win in the Middle East any more than can the ill-conceived ground invasion of those lands.

The reason, which somehow eludes Georgey and his gang, is that we are not confronted with a conventional, national military dictatorship. We are confronted with that age-old enemy of all vast, powerful empires down through history: millions of ragged, sick, starving, ignorant, helpless people who have nothing to cling to but some preacher's promise that someday they will get even with their oppressors and be happy. Today, in this era, that preacher is, or is at least symbolized by, Osama ben Laden and his ethereal Al Qaeda movement.

The preacher, for real...

In more realistic, historic terms, that preacher is those Sheeite Muslim leaders who are convinced that now is the time to rise up and seize power from the Suni Arabs who have held sway in the Middle East

ever since the fall of the Ottoman Turks at the end of World War I, some 90 years ago. It is noteworthy that the Kurds now, also, have some reason to hope they can shake off rule by others.

Because the U.S. and other industrial powers have dealt with Middle Eastern dictators who allied themselves with Suni Muslims to keep the Sheeites (a lot of whom are Persians (Iranians)) and Kurds in line, we have been and still are considered allies of these dictators. By default, then, most Sheeites see us as oppressors.

Therefore, when we use massive bombing and sizeable land forces to attack these people, we—like the Israelis—simply sew hate and resentment among the millions upon millions of dispossessed in the Middle East, and confirm the hateful preaching of outcast leaders such as Osama and a vast chorus of less famous preachers.
