Thinking About Health

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ily she discovered she had been paying smoker rates but was not a smoker. The new premium based on non-smoker rates is \$216, about the maximum she can afford.

A new study from the actuarial firm Milliman just confirmed what the Illinois woman and others already know. Next year's premiums have increased overall compared to 2015 for a variety of reasons such as higher costs for medical care, especially prescription drugs, and lower payments to insurers from the government to cushion the impact of covering lots of sick people.

Milliman compared the second lowest cost silver plans for a 27-year-old and found increases varied with some states like Mississippi and Indiana experiencing decreases and others like Illinois, South Dakota and Nebraska experiencing increases, some significant. In South Dakota, for example, the average increase was 25 percent.

States with fewer insurers tended to have higher increases. That's hardly surprising since competition in health insurance does seem to keep premiums somewhat lower.

No one buys exactly the average policy, of course, or pays exactly the average premium. But it's clear that large numbers of Obamacare policyholders will be paying more next year, and that worries research-

ers, government officials, and supporters of the health law.

The Robert Wood Johnson Foundation and the Urban Institute recently reported that only 35 percent of people eligible for a subsidy--like the one the Illinois woman received--had signed up for a policy last year, and most of them were individuals and families with the lowest incomes. About 80 percent of those with low incomes had chosen policies while only 30 percent with middle incomes in the \$40,000 to \$60,000 range did not.

"People are looking at this and saying 'Man, I can't afford it,'" says Washington insurance consultant Robert Laszewski. He has long argued policies are too expensive and deductibles too high for all except those who get the highest subsidies--in other words, those with the lowest incomes.

Laszewski predicts even higher increases for next year along with higher deductibles and a smaller choice of doctors and hospitals. That's what the Illinois woman is afraid of.

"I didn't expect these kinds of increases year after year," she told me. "It was like the first year was a big come-on. Everybody gets in and the second year they sock it to you."

And for next year? "Who knows," she says. "Still counting down to Medicare."

Bennet, Portman introduce bill to help finance carbon capture, storage projects

Bennet 11/19) – U.S. Senators Michael Bennet (D-CO) and Rob Portman (R-OH) on Thursday introduced a bill to help power plants and industrial facilities finance the purchase and installation of carbon capture and storage equipment. The carbon that is captured can be used for Enhanced Oil Recovery (EOR) or stored underground.

The Bennet-Portman Carbon Capture Improvement Act would allow businesses to use tax-exempt private activity bonds to finance the high upfront capital costs associated with installing carbon capture equipment.

"This bill would reduce upfront costs, one of the largest impediments to carbon capture technology. It is good for the economy and good for the environment," Bennet said. "In Colorado it would enhance our diverse energy portfolio. The captured carbon dioxide can be used by oil producers to extract more oil out of current wells – improving our energy security and boosting domestic energy production. It also reduces emissions from power plants and industrial facilities to help keep our air clean – which is something that Coloradans value and makes our state an attractive place to live. This bipartisan bill is a market-based, technology-neutral approach to attacking the problem that carbon dioxide creates."

"I'm pleased to introduce this bipartisan legislation that will

have real environmental benefits, but also allow states like Ohio to continue to utilize our natural resources," Portman stated.

The Bennet-Portman bill allows businesses to use private activity bonds (PABs) issued by local or state governments to finance a carbon capture project. These bonds are beneficial to consumers and businesses because of their tax-exempt status and because they can be paid back over a longer period of time. If more than 65 percent of carbon dioxide emissions from a given facility are captured and injected under-

ground, then 100 percent of the eligible equipment can be financed with PABs. If less than 65 percent is captured and sequestered, then tax-exempt financing is permitted on a pro-rated basis.

The Carbon Capture Improvement Act would:

- Make CCS projects more economically feasible: The ability to use tax-exempt PABs to retrofit power plants and industrial facilities would help decrease the costs for these types of projects.

- Boost oil production, while conserving land and reducing

emissions: By conducting EOR with recycled carbon dioxide from power plants, producers could increase oil production from already-drilled wells, using less new land. Additionally, carbon dioxide that would otherwise be emitted into the atmosphere would instead be captured and stored.

• Provide greater energy security in the 21st century: The 21st Century Energy Institute at the U.S. Chamber of Com-

merce found in 2014 that Enhanced Oil Recovery already accounted for 350,000 barrels a day of domestic oil production.

“CCS is a crucial tool for reducing carbon emissions, and deploying additional projects will make it more affordable in the US and around the world,” said Armond Cohen, Executive Director of the Clean Air Task Force. “Private activity bonds can reduce the cost of financing projects, which will help

lower the hurdles to getting more steel in the ground.”

“Enactment of this bill can help pave the way for carbon capture utilization and storage projects in the U.S. to be built which in turn will make more CO2 available for enhanced oil recovery and securely storing that CO2,” said Mike Moore, Executive Director of the North American Carbon Capture Storage Association, which is comprised of entities including the American Petroleum Institute, Kinder-Morgan, Occidental Petroleum, Shell, British Petroleum, and the International En-

ergy Association. “Just in the mature fields alone, recoverable oil with CO2 could be over an additional 20 billion barrels. In turn, these barrels add to the growing self-sufficiency of the U.S., augmenting national and economic security as well as the environmental benefits of building clean energy systems and capturing CO2 before it is released.”

In addition, the National Enhanced Oil Recovery Initiative (NEORI), a coalition representing major energy producers, environmental, labor, and state representatives, added their approval.
